



Publication Process

ICSBI Conference Series | ICFTSDE 2026

ICSBI follows a transparent, structured, and ethical publication process that allows participants to present their research at the conference and pursue appropriate publication pathways after the event.

Step One – Abstract Submission

Participants submit an abstract as part of the conference submission process.

Full paper submission is not mandatory at this stage. Authors with completed full papers may submit them voluntarily.

Abstracts are reviewed for relevance, clarity, and alignment with conference themes.

Step Two – Conference Presentation

All accepted submissions must be presented at the conference (face-to-face or online).

Presentation is mandatory for inclusion in conference proceedings and eligibility for post-conference publication consideration.

Step Three – Post-Conference Submission

After the conference, presenting authors receive an official email with submission instructions, a post-conference submission form, and the deadline.

Authors upload their full paper and indicate their preferred publication pathway.

Step Four – Editorial Evaluation & Allocation

The ICSBI editorial team reviews submissions based on the selected publication pathway.

Journal submissions are assessed for scope and academic suitability.

Papers unsuitable for journals may be redirected to the ISBN-registered conference proceedings.

All journal decisions remain independent and subject to peer review.

Publication Pathways

- Conference Proceedings Book (ISBN-registered)
- Journal Submission (by invitation, subject to suitability and independent review)

Conference participation does not guarantee journal publication.

This structured process ensures flexibility for authors, clear separation between conference participation and journal decision-making, and strict adherence to academic ethics and publication standards.
